COMMENTS:

Under the Administration of Franchise and Income Tax Law, this bill would allow individual taxpayers to designate a contribution on the state tax return to a newly created National World War II Veterans Memorial Trust Fund (the Fund).

The April 6, 2000, amendment accepted the department's technical amendments to (1) clarify that the statement that contributions would be for use on the World War II Memorial in Washington, D.C., would be in the accompanying tax information booklet and not on the tax return itself, and (2) provide for reimbursement of the Controller's direct actual costs for the administration of the Fund.

The April 6, 2000, amendment also made a minor change to the Military and Veterans Code which is not discussed because it does not impact the department's programs.

Except for these changes, the remainder of the department's analysis of the bill as introduced February 24, 2000, still applies.
