### COMMENTS:

This bill would declare the Legislature's intent to have a conference committee on taxation.

The May 18, 2000, amendment deleted the earlier provisions of the bill that would have restructured a significant number of tax laws to more closely conform to federal law by referencing the federal code rather than duplicating its language and would have added a vouchering requirement to the Local Agency Military Base Recovery Area and Manufacturing Enhancement Area Hiring Credits. The May 18 amendment inserted the legislative intent language discussed above.

This bill no longer impacts the department's programs and operations or the state's income tax revenue.
