EARNED INCOME TAX CREDIT

You may qualify for cash-back tax credits that can increase your refund when you file your taxes.

The expanded California Earned Income Tax Credit (CalEITC), the Young Child Tax Credit (YCTC), and the federal EITC can combine to put hundreds or even thousands of extra dollars in your pocket.

That's money you can use for rent, school tuition, utilities, groceries, and other important expenses.

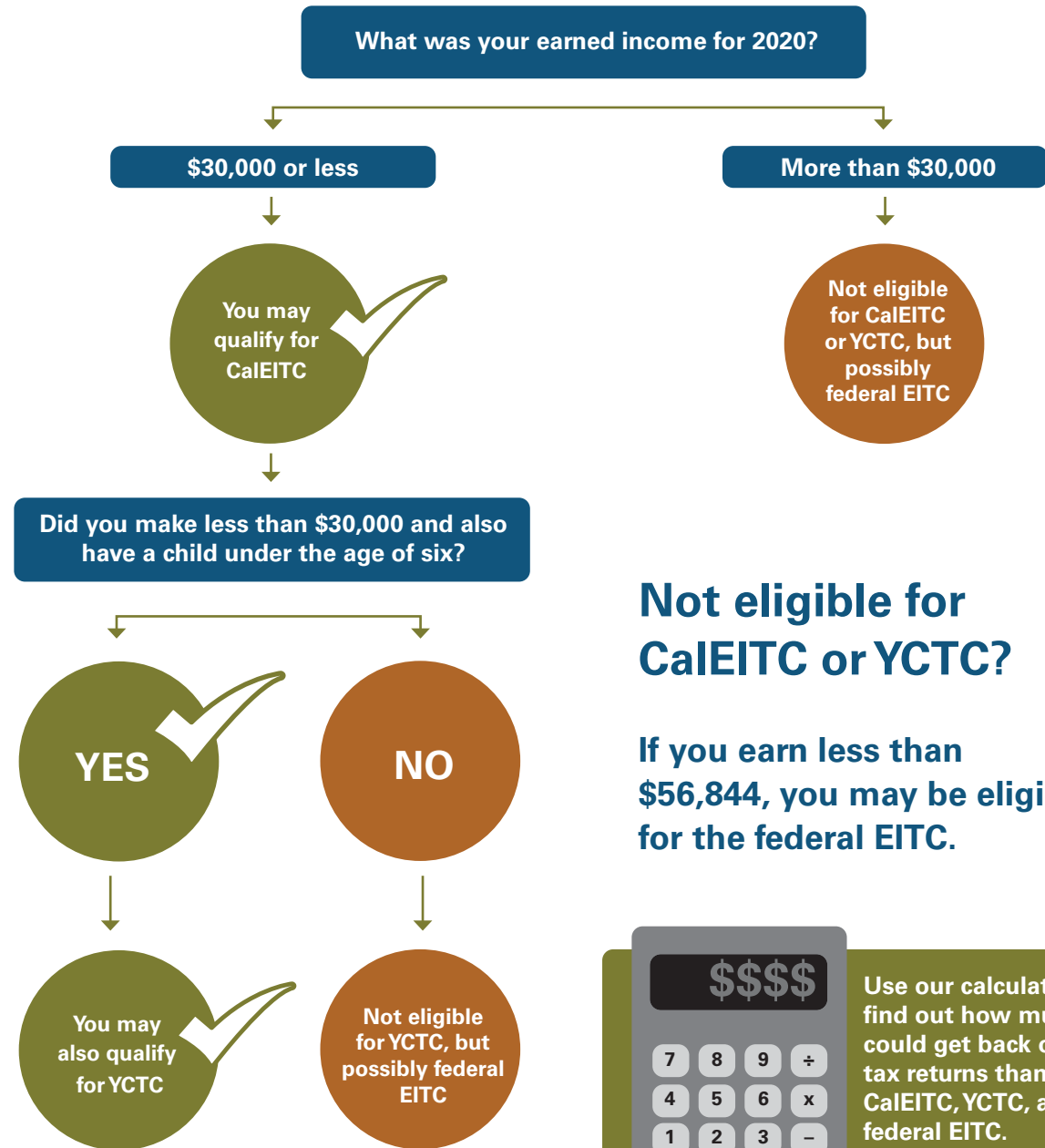
The amount of CalEITC you may be eligible for depends on how much money you earn from work. You may also be eligible if you:

- Are at least 18 years old or have a child.
- Work for an employer or work for yourself.
- Have a Social Security Number or a federal Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN).
- Lived in California at least half the tax year.

If you qualify for CalEITC and have a child under the age of six, you may also be eligible for YCTC.
