SUMMARY

This bill would make numerous technical, nonsubstantive changes as a matter of code maintenance to various California codes, including the Revenue and Taxation Code.

This analysis only addresses the provisions of the bill that impact the department’s programs and operations.

ANALYSIS

The May 16, 2016, amendments made several technical, nonsubstantive changes to several California codes. As a result, there would be no impact on the department’s programs and operations or state income tax revenue.

The department’s analysis of the bill as introduced on February 18, 2016, still applies.
