**SUBJECT: CANCELLATION OF SCHEDULED SYMPOSIUM – APRIL 29, 2002
DISCUSSION DRAFT ADDITION TO CALIFORNIA CODE OF
REGULATIONS, TITLE 18, SECTION 25137-2**

On March 14, 2002, the Franchise Tax Board published FTB Notice 2002-02. Pursuant to that Notice, a symposium was tentatively scheduled for April 29, 2002, to discuss the discussion draft amendments to California Code of Regulations, title 18, section 25137-2. The existing regulation provides special apportionment rules to be applied to long-term construction contracts. The proposed amendments will make those special apportionment rules applicable to long-term contracts for the manufacture or fabrication of tangible personal property.

Under the express terms of FTB Notice 2002-02, if no public interest was voiced and no written comments were received by April 12, 2002, the symposium would be cancelled. Because no public interest has been voiced, nor have any written comments been received, **the symposium has been cancelled.**
