SUMMARY

This bill would, among other things, authorize the Franchise Tax Board (FTB) to collect the penalties for offenses detected by an automated speed enforcement system operated by the City of San Jose or the City and County of San Francisco.

ANALYSIS

The April 6, 2017, amendments, modified provisions relating to the proposed automated speed enforcement pilot program to be operated by the City of San Jose and the City and County of San Francisco. These provisions do not impact the FTB. The department’s analysis of the bill as introduced February 7, 2017, still applies.
