**SUMMARY**

This bill would require state agencies, including the Franchise Tax Board (FTB), to submit a report biennially to the California Department of Technology (CDT) as specified, and would add specified requirements administered by the CDT.

**ANALYSIS**

The July 3, 2017, amendments, modified the California Department of Technology’s responsibilities with regard to adopting a state Web Site accessibility standard. These amendments do not impact the department’s programs or operations. The department’s analysis of the bill as amended March 21, 2017, still applies.
