SUBJECT: State Bar Nontax Debt Collection - Client Security Fund

Minor/Technical Amendment

SUMMARY

This bill, under the Business and Professions Code (BPC), would make several procedural changes related to the Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act, and make several changes to licensee investigative and disciplinary actions related to the State Bar Act. In addition, this bill, under the Administration of Franchise and Income Tax Law, would require the Franchise Tax Board to collect monetary sanctions and costs related to the State Bar of California's Client Security Fund reimbursement provisions, as specified.

ANALYSIS

The July 7, 2020, amendments modified provisions of the BPC related to passage of a law student's examination, as specified. In addition, other technical changes were made. These amendments would not impact the department's programs or operations.

The department's analysis of this bill as amended May 5, 2020 and May 13, 2020, still applies.
