## Summary

This bill would, under the Sales and Use Tax provisions of the Revenue and Taxation Code, add an exemption from the sales and use for certain zero-emission technology medium- and heavy-duty transit bus vehicles and establish reporting requirements for purposes of determining the effectiveness of the exemption.

## Analysis

The April 9, 2019, amendments replaced the Franchise Tax Board with the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration as the reporting agency.

As a result of the amendments, this bill no longer impacts the department's programs and operations or state income tax revenue.
