Summary

This bill, under the Business and Professions Code, the Penal Code, and the Vehicle Code, would repeal the Department of Motor Vehicles' (DMV) authority to suspend the California driver's license (CDL) of a licensee convicted of non-vehicle related crimes, including, among others, vandalism, the illegal use or possession of a controlled substance or alcohol, or the illegal use of a firearm, and make several technical changes.

Summary of Amendments

As introduced on February 21, 2019, this bill would have repealed the DMV's authority to suspend the CDL of a licensee convicted of non-vehicle related crimes, as specified, or included on a certified list, including the department's list of the 500 largest tax delinquencies, and made several technical changes.

The March 25, 2019, and April 8, 2019, amendments added coauthors, eliminated the DMV's authority to suspend a CDL based on a licensee's conviction for lewd and dissolute conduct, and made several technical changes.

The May 17, 2019, amendments made a technical correction and clarified when the bill's provisions would apply.

Bill Analysis Introduced February 21, 2019 and Amended March 25, April 8, May 17, and June 17, 2019

The June 17, 2019, amendments removed the provision that would have eliminated the DMV's authority to suspend the CDL of a licensee included on a certified list. As a result of the June 17, 2019, amendments this bill no longer impacts the department's programs and operations.
