### **SUBJECT**

Building Energy Efficiency Standards; Solar Reflectance of Roofs

- No analysis required – Not within our scope of responsibility.

### **SUMMARY**

The January 3, 2022, amendments removed language relating to a new worker classification exemption for seasonal live theatre workers in the application of the ABC test for the determination of employee or independent contractor status and replaced it with the provisions listed below:

- Under the Public Resources Code, these amendments would require the State Energy Resources Conservation and Development Commission (commission) to consider amendments to the roof replacement building standards in order to increase the value of minimum aged solar reflectance and;
- Require the commission to assess if there is an adequate supply of labor resources and available products in the climate zones the commission is considering for these amendments.

### **ANALYSIS**

The January 3, 2022, amendments removed all references to a new worker classification for seasonal live theater workers and replaced it with the provisions discussed in the summary. As a result of the amendments, this bill no longer impacts the department's programs and operations or state income tax revenue.

The department's analysis of the bill as introduced February 19, 2021, no longer applies.
