SUBJECT

Department of Motor Vehicles Identification Cards

- Technical Amendment

SUMMARY

This bill would amend the Vehicle Code to require the issuance of an identification card, as specified. This bill, under Personal Income Tax Law, would allow the Franchise Tax Board to request the taxpayer to provide identifying documents acceptable for purposes of obtaining the identification card to substantiate the California Earned Income Tax Credit (CalEITC).

This analysis only discusses the provisions that impact the department's programs and operations.

ANALYSIS

The August 11, 2022, amendments updated the CalEITC bill text for recently enacted changes made by SB 201 (Chapter 72, Statutes of 2022), and extended to July 1, 2027, the date by which Department of Motor Vehicles must commence issuing identification cards. With the exception of these changes, the department's analysis of this bill as introduced on February 2, 2022, still applies.

The August 24, 2022, amendments made changes to the Government and Vehicle Codes. These amendments would not impact the department's programs or operations.
