

# No Analysis Required

## **SUBJECT**

Secretary of State Document Filings for Business Entities

No analysis required – Not within our scope of responsibility.

### **SUMMARY**

This bill would, under the Business and Professions Code, Civil Code, the Corporations Code, and the Corporation Tax Law (CTL), update administrative procedures for corporate filings with the Secretary of State (SOS) and make other nonsubstantive technical changes.

### **ANALYSIS**

As introduced, among other things, this bill under the CTL, would have required the SOS to provide taxpayers a filing response, acknowledging receipt of submitted documents, within 21 days of receipt of a corporate certificate of dissolution.

The March 21, 2022, amendments clarified that the SOS must provide taxpayers a filing response within 21 days of receipt of a corporate certificate of dissolution, and made other technical, nonsubstantive changes.

The March 31, 2022, amendments reordered the CTL amendments within the bill.

This bill would not impact the department's programs or operations.
