SUBJECT

Public Employment

SUMMARY

This bill would have, under the Business and Professions Code, Government Code, Penal Code (PC), Vehicle Code, and the Welfare and Institutions Code, among other changes, eliminated a number of administrative fees and costs imposed on a person related to involvement in the criminal justice system and would have specified that the unpaid balance of specified fees or costs eliminated by these provisions would be unenforceable and uncollectable.

ANALYSIS

The September 3, 2021, amendments removed all the provisions of the bill relating to court ordered debt, and replaced those provisions with a technical amendment to PC section 13510.8, which clarifies existing law that collateral estoppel applies to prior appeal proceedings having preclusive effect on the decertification proceedings created by SB 2. As a result of the amendments, this bill no longer impacts the department's programs and operations.
