SUBJECT

State Water Resources Control Board: hexavalent chromium removal from drinking water

- No analysis required – Not within our scope of responsibility.

SUMMARY

This bill, under the Health and Safety Code, would address drinking water safety by appropriating funds for hexavalent chromium removal from drinking water systems.

ANALYSIS

The April 16, 2026, amendments replaced provisions that would have, under the Personal Income Tax Law, for taxable years beginning on or after January 1, 2026, and before January 1, 2030, modified the existing exclusions to eliminate the \$20,000 annual maximum exclusion amount and the adjusted gross income (AGI) qualifications to allow for all retirement pay for retired members of the uniformed services and annuity payments received from Survivor Benefit Plans to be excluded from gross income with no AGI limitation, with drinking water safety appropriations funding.

As a result, the bill no longer impacts the Franchise Tax Board (FTB). The FTB's analysis of the bill, as introduced on February 17, 2026, no longer applies.
