### **SUBJECT**

Charitable Fundraising Platform: Good Standing Requirements

- No analysis required – Not within our scope of responsibility.

### **SUMMARY**

Under the Government Code, beginning on or after January 1, 2027, this bill would remove the requirement that a charitable fundraising platform verify whether an organization's tax-exempt status has been revoked by the Internal Revenue Service. Additionally, this bill would require the charitable fundraising platform to verify if the organization is barred from fundraising by the Attorney General due to a cease-and-desist order, delinquency, suspension, or revocation.

### **ANALYSIS**

The April 13, 2026, amendments reinstated the requirement that a charitable fundraising platform verify that an organization has not had their tax-exempt status revoked by the Franchise Tax Board (FTB). As a result, the bill no longer impacts the FTB.

The FTB's analysis of the bill as introduced on February 19, 2026, no longer applies.
