SUBJECT

Reactive Chemicals: Facilities

- No analysis required – Not within our scope of responsibility.

SUMMARY

This bill would, under the Government Code, add several requirements for cities and counties to consider before approving a building permit for a new, expanded or modified reactive chemical storage facility. In addition, under the Health and Safety Code, this bill would require annual routine inspections of each reactive chemical storage facility, with results of the inspection reported to the California Environmental Protection Agency and make several technical changes.

ANALYSIS

The August 13, 2026, amendments removed the provision of the Personal Income Tax Law, which would have created an income exclusion for settlement amounts received by a qualified taxpayer for claims relating to the May 2026 chemical incident at the GKN Aerospace manufacturing facility. As a result, the bill no longer impacts the Franchise Tax Board.
